What do Industrial Machinery Installation, Repair, and Maintenance Workers do?

Industrial machinery maintenance mechanics are highly skilled workers who maintain and repair machinery in warehouses, distribution centers, and logistics companies. To do this effectively, they must be able to detect minor problems and correct them before they become major. Machinery mechanics use technical manuals, their understanding of the equipment, and careful observation to troubleshoot the cause of the problem. Primary responsibilities of industrial machinery mechanics often include preventive maintenance and the installation of new machinery. When transportation, warehouse, distribution, or logistics operations stop because a machine breaks down, industrial machinery mechanics maintain and repair these very different, and often very expensive, machines.

Training & Educational Opportunities

You will have plenty of employment opportunities as an industrial machinery installation, repair, and maintenance worker once you earn a certificate or associate degree.

As an Industrial Machinery Installation, Repair and Maintenance Worker you will:

- Clean machines and machine parts, using cleaning solvents, cloths, air guns, hoses, and vacuums
- Collaborate with other workers to repair or move machines, machine parts, or equipment
- Collect and discard worn machine parts to maintain machinery and work areas
- Dismantle machines for repair, using hand tools, chain falls, jacks, cranes, or hoists
- Inspect or test damaged machine parts and mark defective areas

Kankakee County employment of industrial machinery installation, repair, and maintenance workers is expected to increase through the year 2020.

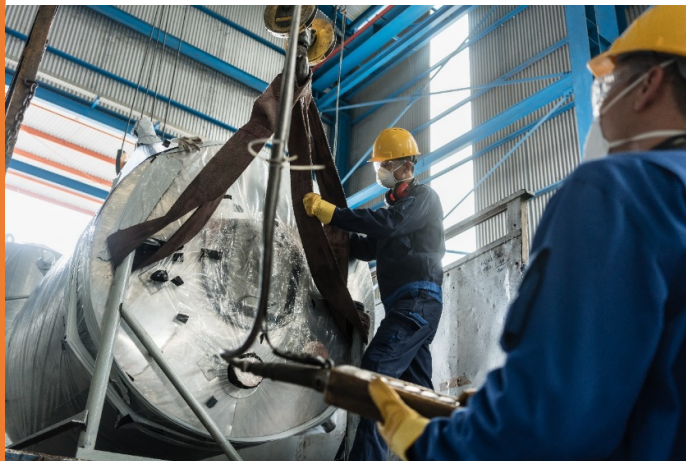
