What do Supervisors of Transportation and Vehicle Operators do?

Supervisors of transportation and vehicle operators directly supervise and coordinate activities of transportation and material-moving machine and vehicle operators. They plan work assignments and equipment allocations to meet transportation, operations, and production goals. They also inspect and test materials, equipment, and vehicles to ensure they are safe and consistent with specifications. Supervisors plan the work activities of the employees they oversee and make sure they have the tools necessary to do their jobs. They may work in the field around equipment, and also in an office setting using computers to help organize and optimize their work productivity.

Training & Educational Opportunities

You will have plenty of employment opportunities as a supervisor of transportation and vehicle operators, but first you will need to obtain an associate degree in supply chain management.

As a Supervisor of Transportation and Vehicle Operators you will:

- Enforce safety rules and regulations
- Direct workers in transportation or services such as moving, storing, loading, and unloading materials or people
- Inspect and test materials, stock, vehicles, and equipment to ensure that they are safe and consistent with specifications
- Review orders, production schedules, blueprints, or shipping or receiving notices to determine work
